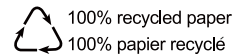

01 Safety Operation and Notice

1. Please read instructions for safety operation carefully before installation and operation. Please save your safety operation guide for future reference.
2. Do not scratch, bend, twist, stretch or heat the power cord as this may cause damage to the power cord, resulting in a fire or electric shock.
3. Do not open the device shell, otherwise it may cause electric shock. If you need to repair, maintain or repair, please contact your local agent.
4. Do not touch the power plug with wet hands as this may cause a fire or electric shock.
5. Do not attempt to modify this device. Failure to do so may result in personal injury or product malfunction.
6. Do not use this equipment near water.
7. If the power cord is damaged (such as a broken wire or bare core), obtain replacement parts from your dealer. Continued use of the equipment with a damaged power cord may result in fire or electric shock.
8. To move the device he power, unplug the power cord, and unplug all connecting cables as this may damage the cable, resulting in a fire or electric shock.

02 System Overview

Relacart launched a new generation of wireless conference discussion system WDC-903, with professional appearance design, perfect circuit composition and stable functional characteristics. It can be used with VTS-2000 automatic video tracking system and central control system to achieve functional diversification.

The data instructions of this wireless conference discussion system are transmitted using the LoRa protocol. The audio works in the UHF band. The high-fidelity circuit design can produce high-quality sound effects. The system has anti-interference protection, which can effectively block the influence of wireless devices such as computers, mobile phones and Bluetooth in the environment.

With automatic search function (AFS) , it can automatically search for a free frequency backup and replace the frequency of the interfered working channel automatically. With automatic and manual activation of the microphone unit, the main controller can turn on the microphone unit automatically. In manual mode, you need to turn on the microphone unit manually in manual mode.

Unique and simple installation design, easy and fast, and has no impact on the installation site, especially for the installation or layout of historical museums, ancient buildings and other historical and cultural buildings. Users do not need to worry about causing damage to ancient buildings. No wiring or drilling is required, providing a professional and perfect solution for demanding and complex applications.

This wireless conference discussion system is fully applicable to local government departments, corporate conference rooms, business venues, and international conference centers.

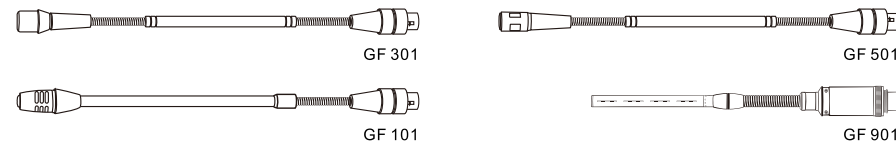
Antenna options



- 1 R-20U panel antenna: beautiful appearance, wall mounting, high gain, wide range of receiving and transmitting signals.
- 2 R-22AU directional antenna: It has the feature of reliable performance, durability, which can provide the best reception effect within the required range. It has gain adjustment, and it can adjust the gain intensity according to the use distance.
- 3 R-20A active antenna booster: Provides gain amplification of the receiving antenna to compensate for signal attenuation on long-distance connection cable and expand the working range and stability of wireless systems.

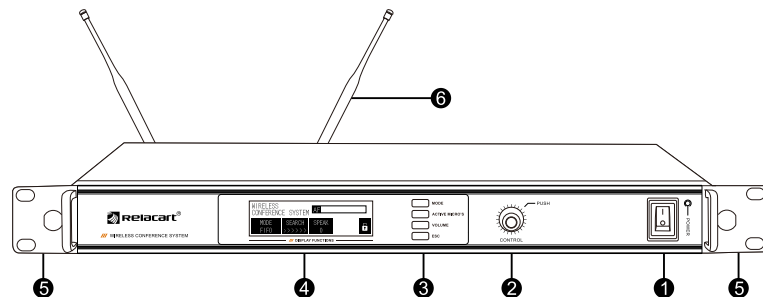

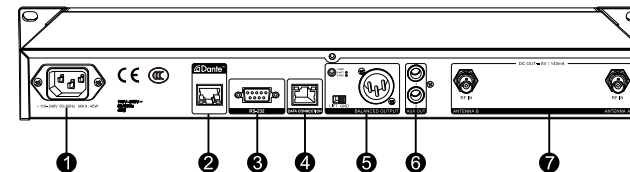

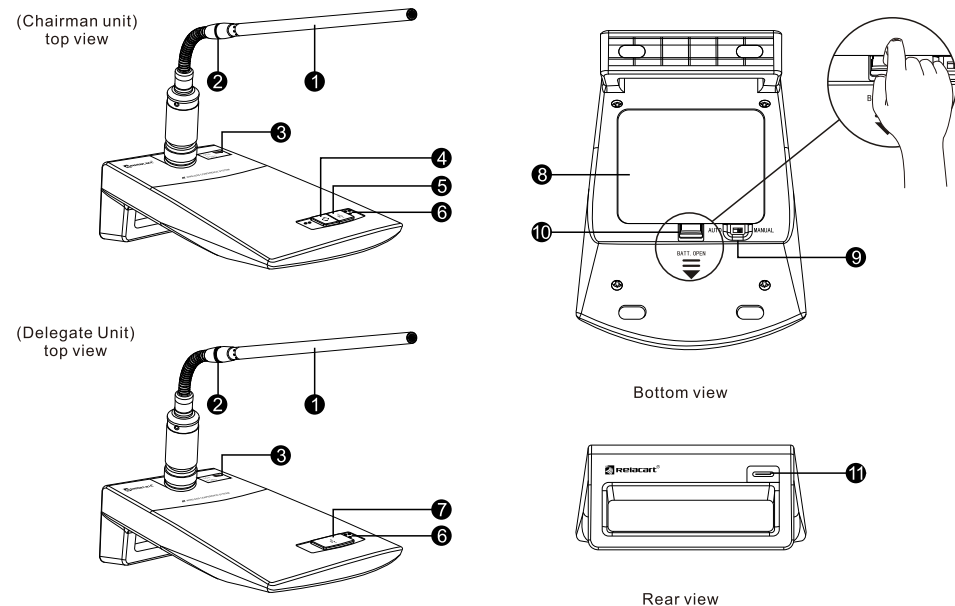
- ❶ POWER switch (with indicator light).
- ❷ Function knob: Press and hold for 3 seconds to enter the function selection menu, select the menu clockwise/counterclockwise, and press to set the system operation menu.
- ❸ Shortcut function buttons:
 - MODE: Short press to enter conference mode selection interface.
 - ACTIVE MICRO'S: Short press to enter the microphone to open the number of speech selection interface.
 - VOLUME: Short press to enter the volume adjustment interface.
 - ESC: Exit key, short press to exit to the previous menu.
- ❹ OLED display interface.
- ❺ Rack mount kit: fixed installation.
- ❻ 1/2 wavelength BNC antenna: It used to receive radio waves transmitted by the transmitter.

- ❶ Power input socket: Standard IEC socket, can adapt to work at 100-240V 50/60Hz AC power.
- ❷ Dante network port: Can connect Dante-supporting equipment.
- ❸ RS-232 port: Can be connected to the automatic video tracking system VTS-2000 or other central control systems to achieve video tracking.
- ❹ LoRa data communication port: Connect DC-903 data communication converter, and then connect to external transmitting and receiving antenna through DC-903.
- ❺ Balanced audio output socket: XLR male socket can be connected to the audio input of the mixer and other equipment using standard two-core shielded cable.
- ❻ RCA audio line output: Can be connected to mixers or recorders and other equipment.
- ❼ BNC antenna port: Connect UHF antenna, can also connect R-20A antenna booster and R-20U / R-22AU external antenna to enhance the signal receiving distance.

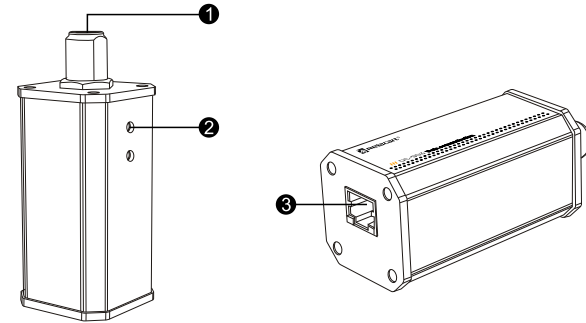
- ① Super cardioid directional: High-quality condenser microphone provides clear and full sound quality, high sensitivity, and good long-distance pickup effect.
- ② Working status indicator: The light is off when muted, the light is on when speaking, the light flashes when waiting for the application, and it will flash when the battery is dead.
- ③ OLED display: Display the working status of the microphone, including conference mode, speaking status, battery indication, ID address, speaking channel light information.
- ④ Chairman unit priority button: Allow the chairman unit to close the delegate unit that is speaking. When applying for the speaking mode, the chairman unit can use this button to disapprove the delegate unit for the application to speak.
- ⑤ Chairman unit speech button:
 - a. When mute, press the button microphone to speak, and then press the button microphone to mute.
 - b. When turned off, press and hold for 1 second to turn on the microphone; when turned on, press and hold for 3 seconds to turn off the microphone.
 - c. In the case of shutdown, press and hold for 3 seconds to enter the "ID pairing" state.
- ⑥ Braille logo: Braille text, which is convenient for people who have congenital defects or damage to the eyes to make them invisible.
- ⑦ Speech key of the delegate unit:
 - a. When mute, press the button microphone to speak, and then press the button microphone to mute.

- b. When turned off, press and hold for 1 second to turn on the microphone; when turned on, press and hold for 3 seconds to turn off the microphone.
- c. In the case of shutdown, press and hold for 3 seconds to enter the “ID pairing” state.
- ⑧ Removable lithium battery box: It provides power for the microphone unit, rated capacity 2900mAH, rated voltage: 3.7V.
- ⑨ Manual/Automatic switch:
 - a. When the switch is set to “AUTO”, the microphone unit is switched to the automatic power-on mode. When the microphone unit is turned off, as long as it receives the power-on signal from the main controller, the microphone unit will automatically power on.
 - b. When the switch is set to “MANUAL”, the microphone unit is switched to the manual power-on mode. The microphone unit cannot receive the power-on signal transmitted by the main controller, and the microphone unit needs to be turned on manually.

Note: In the case of shutting down and removing the battery box, when you switch the switch from “MANUAL” to “AUTO”, you need to manually turn on the microphone unit once and then turn it off before the microphone unit can start the automatic power-on mode.

- ⑩ Battery compartment sliding switch.
- ⑪ TYPE-C charging port: It can charge the lithium battery of the microphone unit, the charging rated voltage is 5V, and the charging rated current is 800mAH.



- ① Antenna input port: N-type female connector, which can be connected to 400-450MHz LoRa antenna.
- ② Screw port: Screw port for wall mount.
- ③ Data communication connection port: RJ45 interface, connected by DC-903 to DATA CONNECTION end of WDC-903M.

11 Setup and Operation

Before the meeting starts, make the corresponding setup for the main controller according to the needs of the meeting, and use the shortcut keys and function coding knobs on the front panel of the main controller to set.

A. Startup main interface

After turn on the power switch, the WDC-903M main controller starts searching for online microphone units for 75 seconds. After the search is completed, the number of online microphone units is displayed.



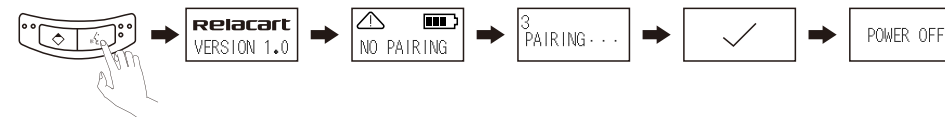
B. Pair the microphone unit with the main controller

The microphone unit needs to be paired with the main controller before data communication. The unpaired microphone will display the “NO PAIRING” interface after it is powered on. The microphone can only work normally after it is paired with the main controller. The pairing operation is as follows:

- Press and hold the coding knob on the main controller panel for 3 seconds to enter the operation interface, select “Meeting Set” - “ID pairing”, the main controller display shows “Pairing.....”.



- In the microphone off state, press and hold the speaking button of the microphone for 3 seconds until the display shows the “PAIRING.....” interface. Then you can release the buttons. At this time, the main controller and the microphone will establish a pairing relationship. After the pairing is completed, the microphone displays a “√” interface and automatically turns off the microphone.



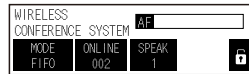
- After all the microphone units have been paired, the main controller exits the “Pairing.....” and returns to the main interface. Then, when the microphone is turned on, the microphone can work normally.

C. Main controller setup

- Press the MODE button on the main controller to enter the conference mode setup. Rotate the coding knob to select one of the four speaking modes: “FIFO”, “LIMIT”, “REQUEST”, and “VOICE activation”.



FIFO: Can active (1/2/3/4/5) microphone units in a time. When speaking microphone over the limit number of speakers who spoke first will be override. (The chairman unit is not limited) to keep the total number of open speaking units.

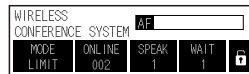

LIMIT: Allow maximum 5 speaking units, and can set the microphone to open 1min to 100 min, when the limited time is reach, subsequent microphone speaks (The chairman unit is not limited). When the number of microphone speech units that have been turned on has reached the preset number (1/2/3/4/5), the delegate microphone units that apply for speech later are in the waiting state (The “LIMIT” displayed on the display of the microphone unit and the microphone indicator will flash, and the host will display the number of microphone speeches and the number of speeches waiting). After the microphone unit that has been opened for speech is closed, the representative unit waiting for speech will automatically start to speak to maintain the total number of open speech units.

REQUEST: The operation of delegate unit should be approved by chairman unit.

- Chairman’s microphone unit approval:
When applying for the speaking mode, the chairman unit has been speaking for a long time. When a delegate unit requests to speak, press the “ ” speak button to allow the delegate unit, and press the “ ” priority button to reject the delegate unit.
- Main controller default approval:
“Enable speak” means that the main controller passes by default when the chairman unit has not approved.
“Disable speak” means that the main controller does not pass the delegate unit by default when the chairman unit has not approved.

“REQUEST” shown on the display when the delegate unit requests to speak The microphone indicator light will flash, and the chairman unit display will show the ID code of the delegate unit and “REQUEST” flashing. At this time, the chairman unit can approve or reject to speak. After the delegate unit speaks 20 seconds, if the chairman unit does not approve it, the main controller will approves it by default. When the number of microphone speeches has reached the preset number of turns on (1/2/3/4/5), the delegate unit request to speak later is in a waiting state (the main controller displays the number of microphone speeches and the number of waiting speeches). When the delegate unit is passed, it will turn off the first one to maintain the total number of open speech units.

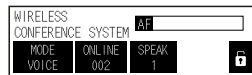

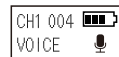

VOICE: When the sound pressure picked up by the microphone unit is greater than the preset threshold, the speech will be automatically turned on. The sound pressure threshold can be set by the “Sensitivity” setting. When set the “Sensitivity” higher, and the lower of sound pressure threshold, it can easier turn on the microphone. Only one delegate unit can speak the under voice activation mode, when the maximum number of speakers is reached, subsequent microphone speaks.

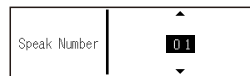

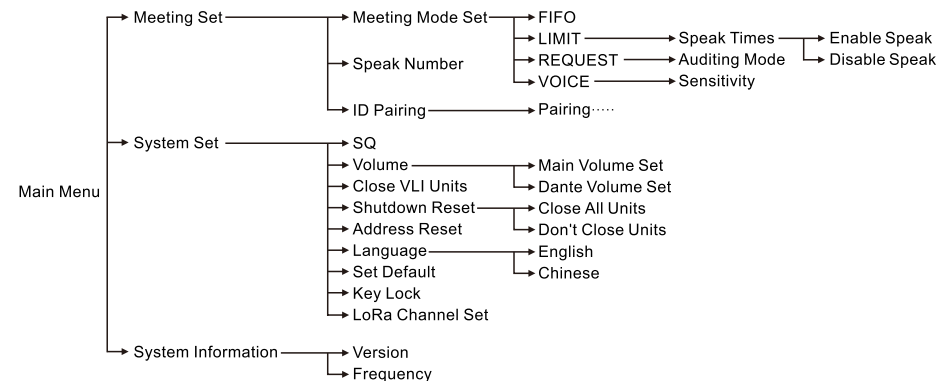
- ② Press the ACTIVE MICRO'S button on the main controller panel to enter the number of speaking unit setting interface. Turn the encoder knob to select the number of microphone units that can speak at the same time. There are 1.2.3.4.5 number options respectively.




- ③ Press the VOLUME button on the main controller panel to enter the volume setting interface. You can set the volume by selecting the “Main Volume Set” and “Dante Volume Set” by turning the encoder knob.
- Main Volume Set: Control the master volume output of the main controller.
 - Dante Volume Set: Control the volume of Dante device input to the main controller.



- ④ Press and hold the coding knob for 3 seconds to enter the menu selection interface. The menu structure is shown below:

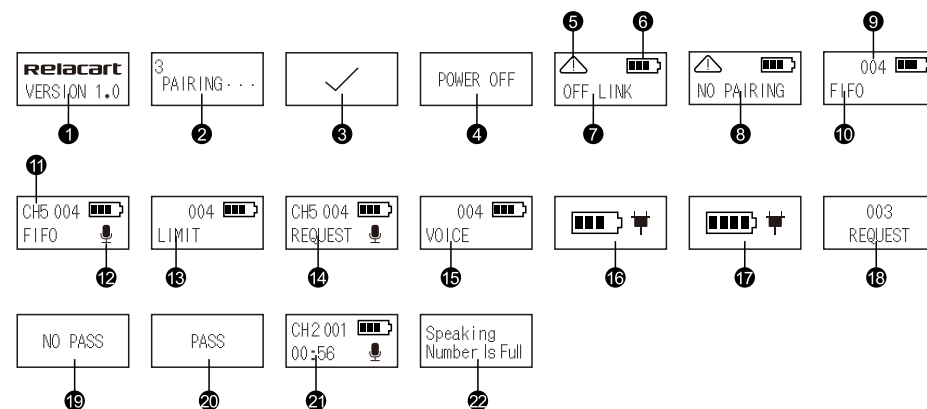


12 Microphone Unit Display Overview

- 1) The conference setup includes three menu items: "Meeting Set", "Speaker Number" Setting, and "ID Pairing". For specific function operations, please refer to the description above.
 - 2) System setup include nine menu items: "SQ" setting, "Volume" setting, "Close VLI units", "Shutdown Reset", "Address Reset", "Language" setting, "Set Default", "Key Lock", "LoRa Channel Set".
 - a. SQ: 0dB to 35dB can be selected according to the application and environment.
 - b. "Volume" setting: Please refer to the operation instructions of the panel shortcut key "VOLUME".
 - c. "Close VLI units": All microphone units are turned off.
 - d. "Shutdown Reset": "AClose All Units" means that the microphone unit will be turned off when the main controller is turned off. "Don't Close Units" means that the microphone unit will not be turned off when the main controller is turned off.
 - e. "Address Reset": Reset the IP address. All microphone units need to be "IP pairing" to obtain the address before they can be used.
 - f. "Language" setting: English and Simplified Chinese for optional.
 - g. "Set Default": The main controller is restored to the factory settings.
 - h. "Key Lock": The main controller's keys are locked, and the function menu cannot be selected. The lock icon on the main controller's main interface is closed . Selecting the function menu indicates "Key Lock".
 - i. "LoRa Channel Set": There are 8 channels to choose. When using more than 2 sets of WDC-903 wireless conference systems on the same occasion, the LoRa channels must be staggered, otherwise crosstalk will occur between the systems.
 - j. Turn on microphone unit settings: Manual/Automatic switching.
 - a. Automatic: When the host is turned on, the host automatically matches the conference base and starts the conference base automatically.
 - b. Manual: When the host is turned on, the host automatically matches the conference base, but does not start the conference base. It needs to be turned on manually.
- Note: 1. This function requires that the conference base is already matched with the host.
 2. When setting the automatic function, the conference base must be set to automatic open to take effect.
- 3) System Information: Includes "System", "Frequency" two menu items.

System: You can view the system software version information.

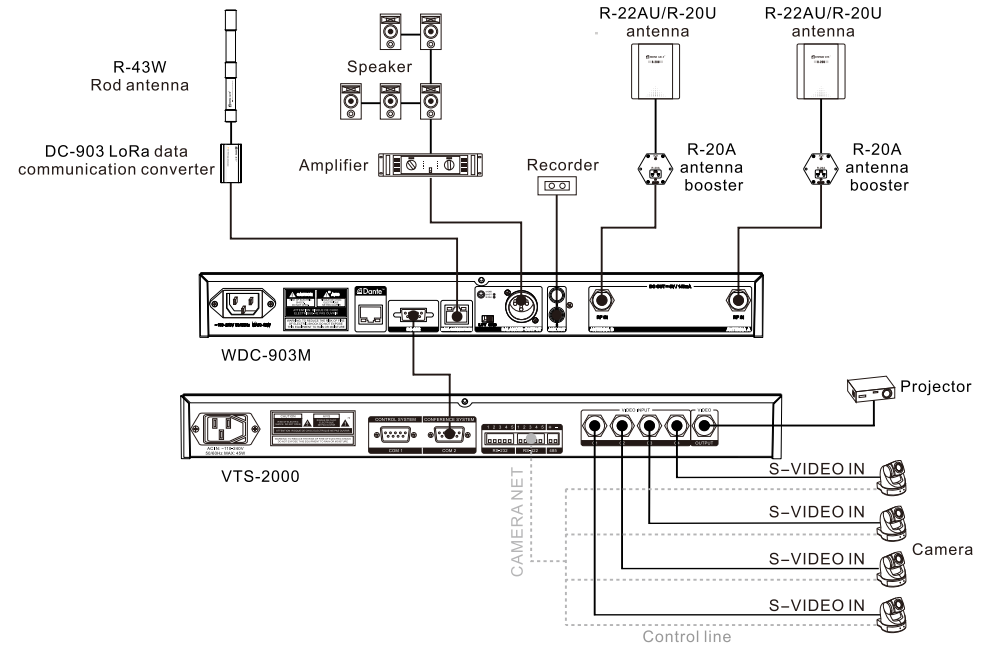

- ㉑ In the time limit mode, the time limit displayed when the delegate unit speaks.
- ㉒ Indicates that the speaking unit has exceeded the maximum number of speakers.



14 Technical Specification

Factors affecting wireless signal transmission in the system:

In order to ensure that the digital wireless conference system can work normally, all signal transmission must not be disturbed.

In addition to using sufficient transmitting and receiving antennas, they must be placed in a reasonable position to ensure that. The wireless signal transmission is uniform and consistent with all wireless conference units in the conference venue.

When planning a digital wireless conference system, factors that affect signal uniformity and strength must be considered.

Installation of wireless transceiver antenna:

Wireless transmission is non-directional and will not be affected by visible light. All the transmitting antennas can. For outdoor use, since the transmission is non-directional, the transmitting antenna is installed in the venue where it is used. Do not install it in the control room, because the transmitting power of the transmitting antenna is only 10mW, and the penetration ability is relatively small. The linear stable transmission distance is about 30 meters. All transmitting antennas must be as close as possible to the infinite conference list. When using a directional antenna, the wireless conference unit has the best sensitivity when facing the transmitting and receiving antenna. And transmit. There must be no obstacles in the space.

Transmitting antenna, no metal near the installation location.
